DAY 2 – MELK

MONDAY 17 MARCH / SHIP ARRIVES MELK 1400 / SHIP DEPARTS MELK 2300

Wake up this morning to the breathtaking scenery of the Wachau Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its picturesque landscapes filled with medieval castle ruins, terraced vineyards and apricot orchards, and charming villages hugging the banks of the Danube. Early birds might enjoy a quick power walk on shore during a short stop. Otherwise, a leisurely start to the day, with afternoon arrival in pretty Melk, best known for its 11th-century Benedictine abbey. Here, you'll take a short transfer to nearby Artstetten Castle for a private event and tour of the 13th-century estate where descendants of Archduke Franz Ferdinand of Austria still reside today. Later, unwind onboard as the ship sails overnight to Slovakia.

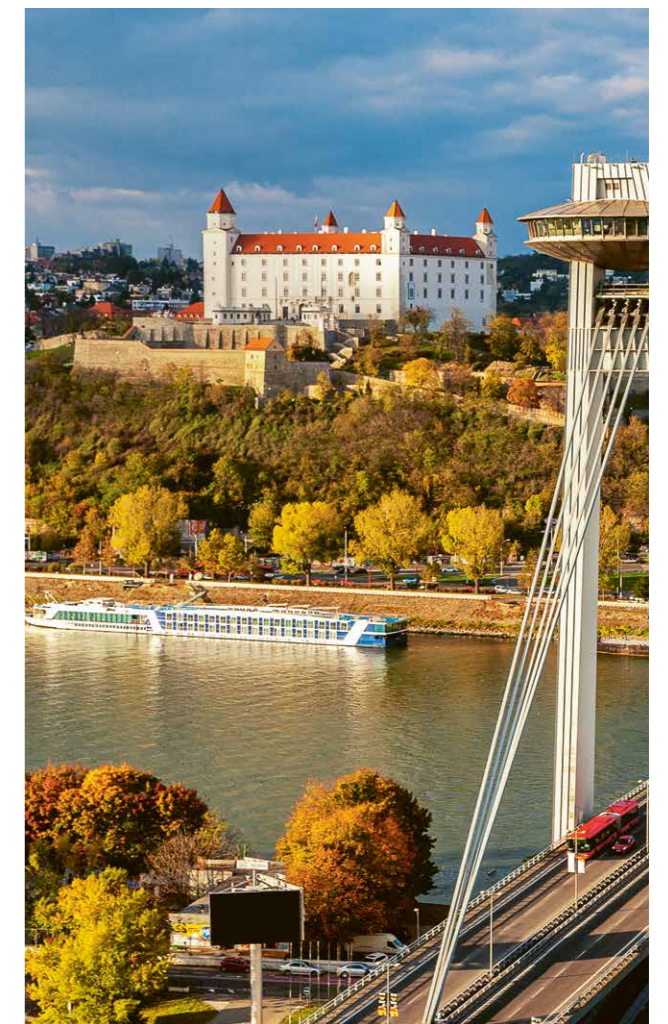
DAY 3 – BRATISLAVA
